Echoes of Silence: Meditation in Monochrome

About the Exhibition

The Garage Art Center is pleased to present *Echoes of Silence: Meditation in Monochrome*, a solo exhibition by New York-–based artist Ami Park.

This immersive presentation invites viewers into a contemplative space shaped by Park's monochromatic series—sculptural works composed of cotton rope, yarn, fabric, and other tactile materials. Through a restrained palette and richly textured surfaces, Park explores themes of inner healing, self-discovery, and the meditative states that underpin her creative process.

This exhibition marks the first public presentation of her monochromatic work in the Queens community, offering a quiet yet resonant visual meditation on the delicate balance between external chaos and inner calm.

In addition to the monochromatic series, the exhibition features selections from Park's *Sweet Spot* and *Threshold* series, as well as new color-based works debuting in Queens. Together, these pieces chart the evolution of Park's material language while revisiting formative inspirations that continue to shape her artistic journey.

Echoes of Silence invites viewers to pause, reflect, and engage with the quiet force of introspection and transformation.

About the Artists

Ami Park is a New York-based visual artist whose multidisciplinary practice blends fashion, textiles, and sculpture to explore themes of identity, memory, and transformation. Originally from Seoul, South Korea, she earned her BFA in Fashion Design from *Parsons School of Design* in 2016.

Park has exhibited widely, with an upcoming two-person show at *Nars Foundation* in 2026. Recent group exhibitions include *Bronx Calling: The Sixth AIM Biennial* at *The Bronx Museum and In the House 3* at *Pen + Brush*. She has participated in residencies at the *LMCC Arts Center on Governors Island* and received grants from the *Rauschenberg Foundation*, *Cerf+*, and the *Puffin Foundation*.

Her work has been featured in *Hyperallergic*, *Observer*, and *Saatchi Art*, which named her a 2022 Rising Star. Park contributes actively to the arts community as a juror for *Apexart's Open Call* and has presented talks at *The Bronx Museum*, *Parsons*, and *SVA*. Her works are included in corporate and private collections in the U.S. and South Korea, including *Jrium* and *Sung Shim Food Group*.
